Code of Conduct Sample

What is a code of conduct?

A code of conduct (sometimes called a code of practice) is a guide of rules and ethics to members of your organisation who ensure they are aware of the standards of conduct that are expected of them. It sets out the standards of behaviour that are expected of all employees, contractors, suppliers and other people who participate in activities in your business. It also sets out the consequences of not following the code.

Key features of a code of conduct

- It is a written document
- It is a clear and concise document
- It is a living document and should be reviewed regularly
- It is a document that is easy to read and understand
- It is a document that is accessible to all employees
- It is a document that is approved by the board of directors
- It is a document that is approved by the relevant regulatory bodies
- It is a document that is approved by the relevant industry bodies
- It is a document that is approved by the relevant professional bodies

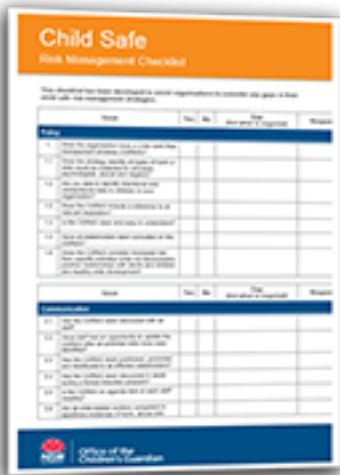
